Councill's Brownstone collection expands

Noted furniture designer John Black bridges classic and modern designs for additions to his successful Brownstone collection for Councill (www.councill.com), introduced this spring at the International Furniture Market in High Point, N.C.

New dining chairs, for example, include a modernized adaptation of a Grecian Klismos form. Distinct for its shaped crest rail, the arm and side chairs have opposing front and back saber legs. The chairs, shown here, come in a rich aubergine finish and supple sky blue leather. The arm chair is \$1,330, and the side chair is \$1,246.

Brownstone draws from classic furniture forms, made relevant for today by scale, proportion and unadorned elegance. To create a truly continental flavor, the collection now reflects periods ranging from Georgian and Louis XVI to Regency and Biedermeier.
